Hello! I'm Richard Adams (or as the children call me) the "I CAN MAN". I'm a former Elementary School Counselor and Music Teacher with Undergraduate and Graduate degrees from James Madison University. This is my 16th year writing and presenting shows as the I CAN MAN. The shows produced for this year are the "Don't Be A Bully Show" and the "SOL Prep Rally Show."

Both the Bully and Test show are designed to engage students by incorporating music, stories, raps and rhymes. All the songs are Sing-Alongs and include hand motions. One thing that I've learned writing and performing thousands of ICAN MAN shows is that repetition, music and movement help the help the learner remember what is being presented.

After seeing and participating in the "Don't Be A Bully Show" the students and teachers will know:

- 1. How to recognize a bully.
- 2. What to say and do when being bullied.
- 3. How to help a friend being bullied.

The I Can Man Shows are show fun and entertaining yet, are firm and consistent about the message of stopping bullying in your school.

The "SOL Prep Rally Show" sells out every year. The shows typically run from early March – June. If there is a fun way to remind the students of basic test taking skills and to motivate them to do their best, this is the show for you. Principals and teachers often comment on how it helps destress both students and teachers. This show works for SOL's in Virginia and EOG's in North Carolina. There are lots of repeat customers so call or email early if you want this show.





I am a professional musician. I play trumpet, a couple of saxophones and banjo during the show. The sound tracks for the show are professionally recorded in the I Can Man studio. The shows are constantly being tweaked for content and music based on comments from students, teachers, principals and parents. I thoroughly enjoy performing, entertaining and educating both students and teachers as the I CAN MAN. Because I personally produce and perform the shows, I feel I'm able to give you a lot of show for the money you are spending. No middle man or booking agents involved. NEED A SCHOOL SONG? "Workshop"

I've helped elementary and middle school students write and record hundreds of school songs. They are typically "peppy" little songs that quickly describe the theme and/or motto of the school They are most often played during the morning announcements.

It works like this! I show up one morning and meet with 15 to 25 children. We take about an hour and compose the "school song". I will then spend approximately 90 minutes sound tracking the song in the mini-recording studio that's set up in a medium sized classroom in the school building.

Then the students that helped write the song come back in the afternoon and record the vocal to the soundtrack. Then I take it back to the "Big Studio" in Staunton, Va and do some tweaking.
